The University is about two miles north of the City Centre on Cottingham Road (B1233) off Beverley Road.

There are plenty of parking areas, free to use for our concerts.

The Middleton Hall, newly-refurbished, is a modern well-equipped concert hall. With excellent acoustics and sightlines, it houses two first class grand pianos and seats 400.

From autumn 2016 tickets booked for Middleton Hall will be allocated a seat number. If you would like to indicate a preference for an area of the hall, please feel free to do so on your booking form.

Disabled access at Middleton Hall has been improved. If you have a disability, please let us know when booking so that an appropriate seat can be reserved for you.
